CATEGORIES:

Learn to Swim:

Swimmers 10 years and under who may have never competed in a swim meet or cannot complete 25m. This category is not eligible for team or individual points. (max 3 events)

Exhibition:

-Swimmers who have not represented Trinidad and Tobago at CARIFTA or higher-level swim meet
-Competitive Masters Swimmers 18 & over may participate in this category
-This category is not eligible for team or individual points. A maximum of 4 events may be swum.

Competition:

Any swimmer who is not designated as competitive by ASATT (maximum 4 events)

ENTRY DEADLINE:

June 23rd, 2023, or when meet capacity (approximately 400 per day) is achieved.

PREFACE: The aim of this meet is to provide an opportunity for swimmers with little to no competitive swimming experience an opportunity to compete and display their abilities. With the meet moving to July from its original month of April, it was reformatted to also provide an opportunity for swimmers to qualify for the Goodwill Swim Meet in St. Lucia or to get a racing opportunity before the Pan Am Master Championships in Trinidad and Tobago.

LOCATION: Centre of Excellence Swimming Pool Complex, 17A Macoya Road, Tunapuna.
25m 8 lane facility. Please note our wading pool will be unavailable for use.

CATEGORIES: Athletes may enter in one category only

- **Learn to Swim:** Swimmers 10 years and under who have never competed in a swim meet or cannot complete 25m. This category is not eligible for team or individual points. (max 3 events)
- **Exhibition:**
 - Swimmers who have not represented Trinidad and Tobago at CARIFTA or higher-level swim meet.
 - Competitive Masters Swimmers 18 & over may participate in this category provided.
 - This category is not eligible for team or individual points. A maximum of 4 events may be swum.
- **Competition:** Any swimmer who is not designated as competitive by ASATT (maximum 4 events)

RULES: World Aquatics Swimming Rules would be enforced for the Exhibition Swimmers (<https://www.worldaquatics.com/rules/competition-regulations>). For the competition category the following infractions will result in disqualification:

- Relay False Starts
- Swimming the wrong stroke in an event
- Substitution
- Swimming out of age group or in the wrong category
- Failing to finish the required distance.

TIMING: Three timekeepers per lane will be used in the absence of Automatic Timing Equipment, (World Aquatics Rule 1.2.3 Where Automatic Officiating Equipment is not available, such equipment must be replaced by a chief timekeeper. Wherever possible, a minimum of one (1) timekeeper per lane shall be appointed together with one (1) additional timekeeper in case of a watch malfunction. It is advisable that there shall be three (3) timekeepers for each lane.”)



LTS EVENTS: Learn to Swim Events will be done with the aid of a volunteer in the water. Swimmers in this category may swim a maximum of three events and may either swim:

- Noodle Race and/or kickboard race OR
- Back Kicks, Freestyle and/or Kickboard

Please also note:

- Back Kicks may be done with or without a board.
- Kickboard race is freestyle kicks with board.
- For the noodle race, swimmers complete the distance with an untied noodle under the stomach.

SEEDING: -For Exhibition and Competition Categories, Teams are encouraged to place entry times on forms or Hytek to enable efficient seeding of the meet.

-Exhibition events will be swum mixed.

-Some competition events will be swum combined as per event listing, but results will be broken down as per age group

AGE GROUPS: 8 & U - Born in 2015 or later 9 - 10 - Born 2013 or 2014
11 - 12 - Born 2011 or 2012 13 - 14 - Born 2009 or 2010
15 - 17 - Born 2006, 2007 or 2008 18 & O - Born 2005 or prior

These age groups apply to the competition and exhibition groups only. Learn to Swim will be Swum as per event listing.

SCORING: Individual Event Scores- Competition Category

1st 9 2nd 7 3rd 6 4th 5 5th 4 6th 3 7th 2 8th 1

Two persons per team may score team points. In the calculation of individual awards, swimmers would be assigned points above as per place achieved. Relays will earn double points and only one relay team per club will earn team points. There is no restriction to the number of relays a swimmer can participate in. Mixed relays must have 2 males and 2 females.

- Results will be posted on an area to be announced at the facility.
- All results will be timestamped. Coaches have up to 20 minutes following posting to lodge queries. Only the officials listed on the school form can make said queries.
- Only team points will be printed on the event results.

AWARDS: -COMPETITION: All participants receive a participation token. The top 8 swimmers overall in each competition age group per gender will be awarded. In the event of a tie, swimmers ranking in individual events would break the tie. For example, where points are similar, the swimmer with more first place finishes will win the awards. Where this is equal, second place finishes will be considered and so on.

-LEARN TO SWIM: All participants will receive a participation token with heat winners also winning a token

-EXHIBITION: World Aquatics High Point Awards will be presented in each exhibition age group in each gender. <https://www.worldaquatics.com/swimming/points>

MEET MGMT: IAMWI Sports Solutions shall be responsible for the management of the meet and will appoint meet officials as necessary. Clubs are to nominate a minimum of one volunteer each to assist with officiating. Intermissions may be added at the discretion of the meet manager in consultation with the referee.

ENTRIES: Entries must be submitted by Saturday June 23rd 11:59pm to entries@iamwisports.com using Hytek Team Manager format.
