CATEGORIES & AGE GROUPS: Athletes may enter in one category only. <u>Developmental Athletes</u> have not participated in a ASATT National Meet and/or represented Trinidad and Tobago in the last three years. Any swimmer who is not a developmental swimmer, is classified as competitive. Events MAY be swum combined but will be scored according to age group:

#### RULES:

World Aquatics Swimming Rules would be enforced for the Exhibition Swimmers

(<u>https://www.worldaquatics.com/rules/competition-regulations</u>). For the developmental category the following infractions will result in disqualification: Relay False Starts, Swimming the wrong stroke in an event, Substitution, Swimming out of age group or in the wrong category, Failing to finish the required distance.

#### **SPECIAL EVENT RULES**

#### SKINS-

- A SKINS event is an exciting series of back-to-back races which operate on a knockout basis, with the two remaining swimmers racing each other in a head-to-head final race.
- The top 8 girls and top 8 boys, based on their 50m swim at the meet (events 20, 21, 24, 25, 30, 31, 42, 43) will be invited to compete. These are the top 8 overall among all age groups making the skins event an open event.
- Should swimmers be unavailable up to 12<sup>th</sup> place may be selected to compete.
- Following the first round of 8, the top four fastest swimmers from the first will return to the blocks to swim a second round, with the final round being the top two from the second skins round. SKINS EVENTS WILL ATTRACT BONUS POINTS FOR CLUBS.

**MYSTERY MEDLEY RELAY-**Each team in this event must have two swimmers of each gender. Backstroke swimmers will start in the water for the first length. After the first swimmer starts, one of the remaining swimmers will select the name of the next stroke from a hat, and the relevant athlete proceeds to the blocks for the next leg.

**KICKBOARD RELAY-** Kickboard events start in the water. Swimmers from the first leg must touch the wall with hand or board and hand over to the next swimmer on the deck who jumps in with the board. This process continues until all four swimmers complete their legs.

**USE OF BLOCKS -** The starting blocks are to be used by competitive swimmers only.

#### **UNDERWATER FLY RELAY**

- Each swimmer must swim 25 underwater with head remaining under water for the full length following the dive
- Swimmer's hands must be together for the duration of the swim
