
We hope this event ignites excitement around swim meets and encourages athletes to embrace competitive swimming in the future. We look forward to your participation!

CATEGORIES

- 1. Exhibition (Exh):
- 10 & U Learn to Swim athletes who cannot yet swim 25m. Learn to Swim Events will be done with the aid of a volunteer in the water. Back Kicks may be done with a board. Kickboard race is front glide & kick with board. No timekeeping for these races.
- Masters Swimmers 18 & over may participate in this category.
- This category is not eligible for team or individual points.
- 2. Competition -Any swimmer who is not designated as competitive by ASATT. For the competition category the following infractions will result in disqualification:
 - Relay False Starts
 - Swimming the wrong stroke in an event
 - Substitution
 - Swimming out of age group or in the wrong category
 - Failing to finish the required distance.

EVENT NOTES

- 1. Female events are odd numbered while Male events are even numbered.
- 2. Open Relays have no restrictions on number of persons per age group. e.g. 10 & U Open Relay may have four (4) 10 year olds (Events 17, 18, 27, 28, 41, 42, 55, 56)
- 3. Open Individual events are scored in the listed age group only, and points will be added to age group scores
- 4. Combined age group events will be scored as per age group e.g.. 13 17 will be broken down into 13 14 and 15 17
- 5. This event can be swum by Masters but only on an Exhibition Basis

- 1. Three persons per team may score team points. In the calculation of individual awards, swimmers would be assigned points above as per place achieved.
- 2. Results will be posted on an area to be announced at the facility
- 3. All results will be timestamped. Coaches have up to 20 minutes following posting to lodge queries. Only the officials listed on the school form can make said queries
- 4. Only team points will be printed on the event results
- 5. All Open Competition Events score double points for Teams and Individuals
- 6. Exhibition Events earn no points
- 7. Each team may enter any number of relay teams per relay event. Only two teams may score team points.



AMARDS



- 1. Top 3 swimmers per competition event will earn a medal
- 2. Top 3 teams per relay event will earn medals
- 3. Top 3 swimmers overall per competition age group will win high point trophies
- 4. Heat Winners for Learn to Swim Events will win a ribbon
- 5. All meet participants will earn a participation ribbon
- 6. Special Award will be given to the top 10 & Under Team, top 11 & Over team, Top Boys Team and Top Girls Team.
- 7. Top three teams overall will win a trophy
